What we are learning about this week:

English Language Arts

We are learning to.....

Writing & Grammar: Write sentences with capital letters and full stops. Share feedback for editing and revising.

Phonics: Associate the consonant sound /o/ /k/ /e/ with the spelling of /o/ /k/ /e/ words. Read words with the consonant sound /o/ /k/ /e/.

Listening and Reading Comprehension: Share information orally. Use basic vocabulary for describing families. Ask for information. Discuss oral passages. Use a graphic organizer to take notes. Analyze sayings. Discuss the setting of a reading. Use setting to retell a reading. Write the setting of a reading.

Vocabulary & Spelling Words: Understand and use basic vocabulary. Understand and read high-frequency words. Use basic vocabulary for describing what is around us at home.
