English Language Arts

Writing & Grammar:

Write sentences with adjectives. Employ self-corrective techniques for editing and revising. Describe with increasing specificity and detail. Use adjectives to describe objects. Write sentences with adjectives. Monitor written language production

Phonics: Associate the consonant sound /oa/ with the letter j. Read words that begin or end with the consonant b and vowels, ai.

Listening and Reading Comprehension: Share information orally. Use basic vocabulary for describing families. Ask for information. Discuss oral passages. Use a graphic organizer to take notes. Analyze sayings. Discuss the setting of a reading. Use setting to retell a reading. Write the setting of a reading

Vocabulary & Spelling Words: Understand and use basic vocabulary. Understand and read high-frequency words. Understand the general meaning of spoken language
