4 = Brown

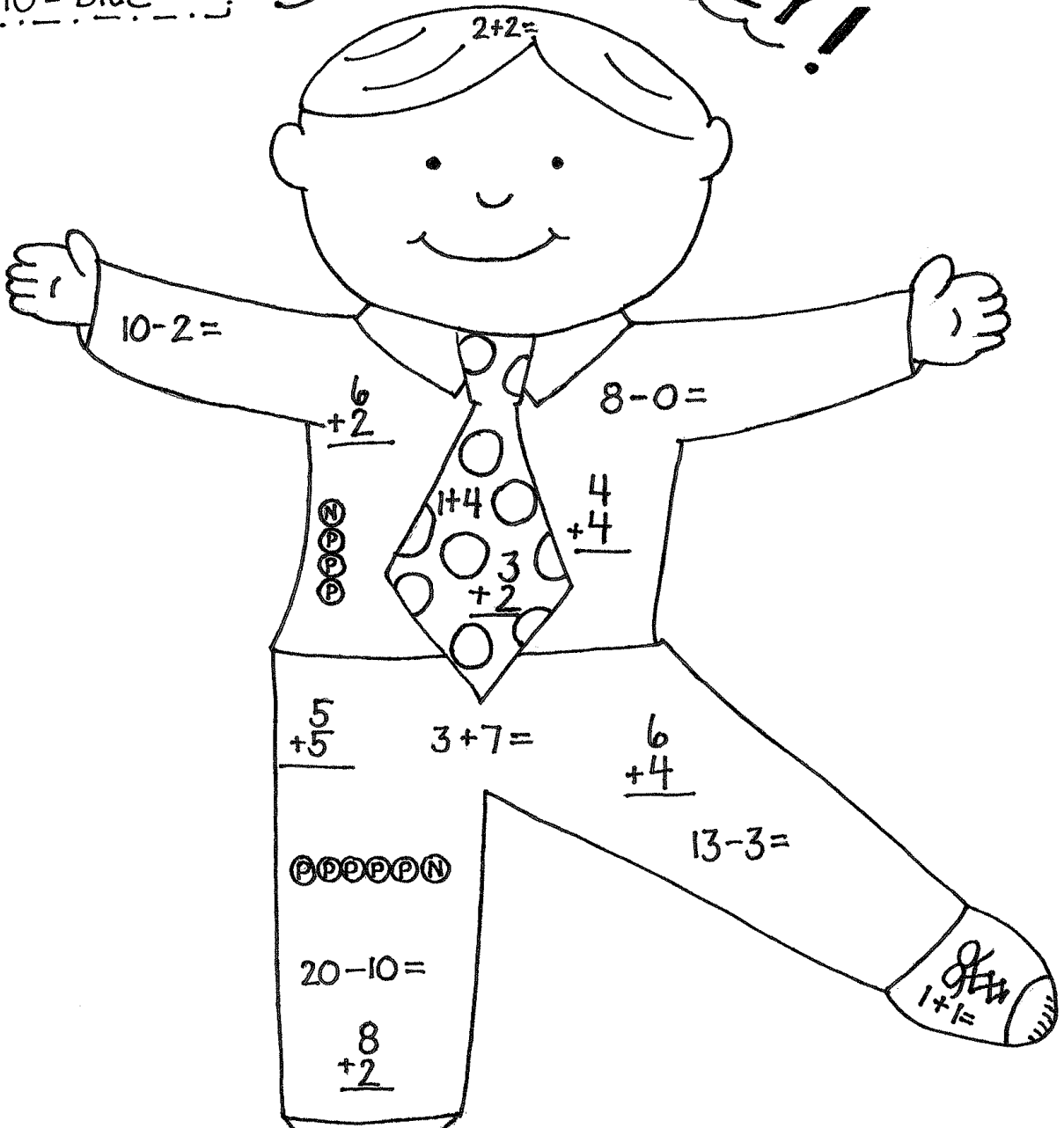
5 = Green
