What we are learning about this week:

English Language Arts

We are learning to.....

Writing: Write narratives in which they recount two or more appropriately sequenced events, include some details regarding what happened, use temporal words to signal event order, and provide some sense of closure. Print all upper- and lowercase letters. Use verbs to convey a sense of past, present, and future

Phonics: focusing on the 'er' sound

Listening and Reading Comprehension: 1) Ask and answer questions about key details in a text. 2) Identify the main topic and retell key details of a text. 3) Describe the connection between two individuals, events, ideas, or pieces of information in a text.

Vocabulary & Spelling Words: Understand and use basic vocabulary. Understand and read high-frequency words. Understand the general meaning of spoken language

Our Spelling Words: day, did, get, bus, truck, must, noise, shadow

Mathematics

- Fact triangles
- Counting forwards/backwards on the number line
